

## Group Site 5: Sinclairs Lane, Walmer



### Start point of the preferred search area

### Connecting Country Priority Habitat Zone: Nuggetty

**Site Description:** There is very little public land in the Nuggetty zone. This small roadside remnant with dam is listed as "uncategorised public land". This site features an open patch of Box-Ironbark Forest with large old Grey Box and Yellow Gum trees. It may be a honeyeater or even Swift Parrot hotspot.

**Getting there:** The Sinclairs Lane group site is less than one kilometre south of Fogartys Gap Rd, on the corner of Sinclairs lane and Troys Rd, in Walmer. Approximately 160 m north of the corner of Sinclairs lane and Troys Rd, there is a fenceline, with a small steel picket. There is a safe space to park here.



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**Preferred Survey Method:** 20 Minute 2 Hectare search: as seen on the map, the small remnant is a triangle shaped piece of land, with each boundary approximately 165 – 175 metres in length. Walk around the remnant in the directions as indicated by the white arrows, and record all birds seen and heard both within the remnant and on both sides of the roadside.
