

National Landcare Conference 2016 – call for abstracts

The call for the submission of abstracts for presentations (and posters) at the 2016 National Landcare Conference is now open.

The conference, to be held between 21-23 September 2016 at Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Centre, will centre around conference theme '**Collaborative Communities – Landcare in Action**'.

Presenters should look to showcase Landcare's approach to natural resource management and sustainable agriculture.

Themes: presentations for the concurrent session streams are sought under the following themes:

- Climate Impacts and Responses
- Community Engagement
- Landscape Challenges and Responses
- Collaboration and Innovation

Who can Submit an Abstract: anyone who is involved in Landcare can submit an abstract such as farmers, volunteers, Landcare groups/networks, natural resource management organisations, primary industry representatives, environmentalists, conservationists, and academics/researchers etc.

Date for Submission of Abstracts: abstracts need to be submitted by **Monday 9 May 2016**

How to Submit an Abstract: abstracts for the 2016 National Landcare Conference can be submitted via the Landcare Australia Communities Portal - see details below.

1. Login or 'sign up' as a user on the [Landcare Australia Communities Portal](#)
2. Click on 'Create Application'.

Note - If you wish to leave a partially completed abstract, press 'Save' and log out. You can log back in and continue to edit your abstract by clicking on your application number (e.g.GA-000004342), until you are ready to submit.

3. To submit your abstract, select the 'Is your abstract submission complete?' checkbox and press 'Save'.

You will receive a confirmation email when when your application has been successfully submitted.
